

# Job Boards for Planners

A Guide for Students in the Department of Urban and Regional Planning

Job boards are search engines that connect job seekers and employers using job posting and resume databases. Many offer free personalized job alerts, career advice, and job fairs. They are valuable resource tools to research trends, identify employers who are actively hiring and for what types of jobs and salaries. Some job boards utilize applicant tracking systems to help streamline the application process. Others redirect interested candidates to employer or their recruiter's websites to complete the application process. It is important to understand how they work, which ones are reliable, and target the ones that are best for the job types you are seeking.

Because of the high number of applications received on mainstream general job boards, planners should cultivate other job search strategies. For novice planners, strategies include targeting specialized job boards and networking with professional organizations, volunteering for nonprofits and professional associations to gain specific skills and build relationships, conducting informational interviews with professionals who may be able to make referrals and introductions, and working with mentors and career coaches. For seasoned planners, this may include contacting executive search firms with knowledge in specific fields.

Most job boards charge companies or organizations for job posts. Pricing structures range from per post costs, monthly fees, fees based on per online click. Small organizations will post job opportunities on solely on their websites due to limited financial and human resources.

Below is a selection of job boards of interest to aspiring and seasoned planners who are seeking opportunities in planning or allied professions in California, the U.S. and abroad. The list is not exhaustive but will help you learn about job boards for Government, Planning, Nonprofits, Specialized, International as well as Employee-Centric Companies and those dedicated to Diversity, Inclusion and Veterans and General. Sign up to receive free email alerts for specific types of jobs and register for an account if you want to be an active user of the site. Test out different keywords to find the best fit for the types of jobs you are seeking.

If you have identified organizations or agencies where you would like to work, contact the human resources or talent department to inquire which sites they use to list their job announcements and request alerts if they offer this service.

Job seekers should maintain a job log to monitor the status of their applications, interviews, and track the candidate search process. During an economic downturn and the uncertainty associated with the pandemic, job seekers should expect to apply to 50+ jobs that match their qualifications and be prepared for searches to be cancelled or delayed because of budget issues. Retain copies of job announcements, applications, and cover letters in case you need to refer to them in interviews. Confirm your applications have been received and contact employers to obtain feedback on your qualifications and interview performance if you were not selected. Periodically review your job log to determine turnaround times for applicant review and approval processes and adjust your expectations accordingly.

Finally, job seekers should read the job descriptions in their entirety and objectively determine that they meet minimum qualifications. Answer supplemental questions in a thoughtful and informative manner and

make sure your cover letters are professionally written and state why you are interested in the position and how you will be able to utilize your skill set to perform the job duties. Make sure that your LinkedIn profiles are updated and consistent with content and accomplishments in their resumes.
